

Q. Who can apply for a grant?

A. Applications may be made by **Individuals** or **Groups**.

Individuals must be residents of Casterton, defined as anyone on the Casterton Electoral Roll, or who has taken up residence since the Electoral Roll was last updated.

Groups should be a not for profit organisation.

Q. Who **can't** apply?

A. Businesses, local government at any level, political parties or activists and religious organisations promoting themselves.

Q. How often can I/we apply.

A. Once annually.

Q. Do I need to give estimates?

A. Yes (if applicable)

Q. How do I/we apply

Q. What type of applications does the trust fund?

A. Applications must be of benefit to the community of the Parish of Casterton.

Q. Can young people under 18 apply?

A. Their parent/guardian would have to apply and present the young persons idea.

Q. Do I need receipts?

A. Yes and presented within 6 months to cctsecretary@castertonvillage.org. or to The Secretary, Casterton Community Trust in secure letterbox at Casterton Village Hall.

Q. Do you need annual accounts from **Group** applications?

A. These may be requested.

Q. Do **Individuals** need to submit accounts?

A. No.

Q. Do I/we declare any other funding applications.

A. Yes

Q. Can I come and present my idea.

A. Yes, we would welcome your input but it's not necessary.
